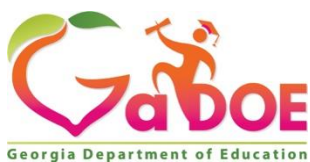


The Georgia School Climate Survey 2024-2025

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What is the purpose of this survey?

To measure what students think about their school.

How will the data be used?

To help school leaders create a better place to learn.

How long will it take?

How many questions are there?

27 questions

Is the data kept confidential?

Answers are not linked to names in any way. When you type answers, do not give names or information that you don't want to share with others.

Am I required to answer every question?

Please skip questions you do not feel comfortable answering or questions that do not apply to you.

Definitions:

Adults - Any adult who works in the school and interacts with students.

Bullying – when someone is mean on purpose, over and over again, to hurt another person or make them feel scared at school or during any school activity such as waiting at a school bus stop, riding the school bus, or watching a school concert or sporting event. It can happen through words, actions, or writing, and it makes it very hard for the person being bullied to learn because they feel unsafe or uncomfortable at school.

Cyberbullying – when someone uses phones, computers, or the internet to be mean, threatening, or harass others online while at school or during online school activities. It can include sending hurtful messages or sharing embarrassing photos or videos.

Teachers - All teachers, including math, English language arts, science, social studies, art, music, PE, or any other school subject. Students should think about all their teachers when answering questions.

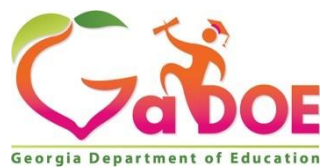
